PUBLIC MANAGER PROGRAM

The State of Nevada's Certified Public Manager (NVCPM) Program currently offers public sector supervisors and managers the opportunity to enhance their leadership skills. Graduates from the NVCPM Program also receive experience and educational equivalencies for their participation. The Division of Human Resource Management has approved the following equivalencies for NVCPM graduates:

Graduation from the NVCPM Program is equivalent to 1 (one) year toward the minimum education qualifications or 1 (one) year of supervisory/managerial experience required for a State position.

The NVCPM Program is a nationally recognized and accredited leadership development program for the public sector. Upon graduation, successful candidates receive the professional designation of Certified Public Manager (CPM).

The curriculum consists of more than 300 hours of structured learning activities designed to develop core skills of managerial excellence in government to create world-class leaders in the public sector and make government more efficient. The program not only contributes to the effectiveness of State of Nevada operations but also provides personal development for employees.
