## **REGULATION CHANGES PROPOSED FOR PERMANENT ADOPTION**

**Explanation of Proposed Change:** LCB File R077-11 made changes to NAC 284.210 Differential rate of pay for qualifying shift. This amendment will allow those changes to expire by limitation on July 7, 2013, and NAC 284.210 will revert back to the previous language. This amendment was recommended by AFSCME Local 4041 and was agreeable to the directors of the agencies that had requested the original changes to the shift differential regulation.

## LCB File R077-11 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. LCB File No. R077-11, which was adopted by the Personnel Commission and filed with the Secretary of State on December 30, 2011, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be designated as section 2, immediately following section 1, to read as follow:

Sec. 2 This regulation expires by limitation on July 7, 2013.
