The Nevada Gaming Control Board is seeking qualified applicants for an entry-level Agent position. The successful candidate will initially be assigned to the Corporate Securities section of the Investigations Division but could be reassigned to another section of the Investigations Division in the future. This is an unclassified full-time position within the State of Nevada system.

Recruitment: This is an open recruitment, open to all qualified persons.

The Position: Under limited supervision, an Agent in the Corporate Securities Section of the Investigations Division investigates public entities applying for gaming approvals; monitors the activities of such gaming entities and any affiliated gaming licensees; prepares investigative reports on gaming applications for presentation to the Nevada Gaming Control Board and Nevada Gaming Commission; completes assigned special projects; and performs other duties as assigned.

<u>Minimum Qualifications</u>: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree in finance, business administration, economics, accounting or other applicable degree; or professional level experience in the areas of: accounting, banking, finance, securities analysis and offerings, federal/state securities laws and regulations, financial analysis and/or investigation of white collar crime or closely related experience.
