Chief, Audit Division

The Nevada Gaming Control Board is accepting applications from qualified applicants for the position of Chief, Audit Division.

The Position:

Under the general direction of the Nevada Gaming Control Board (Board) this position is responsible for the statewide management of the Audit Division with office locations in Las Vegas and Reno, Nevada.

- Responsible for the management of the Las Vegas and Reno Nevada Audit Division staff and offices
- Responsible for maintaining and improving the audit cycle for Group I Licensees
- Develops and authorizes the implementation of Division policies and procedures within the parameters of the Board's policies
- Recommends and participates in the development and implementation of regulations and statutes
- Reviews and approves correspondence according to Division and Board policy, including audit reports, audit committee summaries, petitions for refunds and redeterminations, minimum internal controls standards and variations, waivers of regulations, etc.
- Acts as the appointing authority, at the Chairman's discretion, for employee promotions, hiring and terminations within the Audit Division
- Attends Board, Commission, and other meetings as appropriate; testifies and makes public presentations
- Responsible for proposing the Audit Division's biannual operating budget and monitors expenditures of the approved operating budget

Minimum Skills/Qualifications:

Graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree in accounting or business administration, possession of an active Nevada CPA certificate and seven years of experience in an accounting, auditing or financial analysis environment, including four years as a supervisor and two years managing supervisors.

Location:

The Chief, Audit Division is located in Las Vegas, Nevada. Frequent travel including extended visits to Reno and Carson City, Nevada may be required.
