The Bureau's caseloads consist of delinquent youth committed to state correctional facilities, youth on parole from such facilities, youth referred to Nevada for parole supervision from other states through the Interstate Compact (NRS 214), youth committed to the Division of Child and Family Services who require both correctional and Mental Health residential treatment, and youth under the age of 12 who are committed to the Division of Child and Family Services for correctional care, but who cannot by law be placed in a correctional setting.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE: A Bachelor's degree or Master's degree with major course work in social work, criminal justice, business administration, public administration or other field related to juvenile services. The preferred candidate will have a minimum of 4 years successful management and leadership experience administering comprehensive juvenile services programs embodying rehabilitative or delinquency prevention concepts as well as mental health programming for juvenile offenders. Applicants with education at the Masters level or higher are encouraged to apply and will receive strong consideration during the interview process for this crucial position.
