RECRUITMENT OPEN TO:

This is an open competitive recruitment, open to all qualified applicants. This position is appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the Insurance Commissioner.

AGENCY RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Nevada Division of Insurance has an annual operating budget of approximately \$17 million, employs 85 staff with offices in Carson City and Las Vegas. The Mission of the Nevada Division of Insurance is to protect the rights of Nevada consumers in their experiences with the insurance industry and to ensure the financial solvency of insurers.

APPROXIMATE ANNUAL SALARY:

Up to \$90,000 plus benefits * (*Salary range reflects retirement (PERS) contributions by both the employee and employer. An employer paid contribution plan is also available with a reduced gross salary.*)

*Please note: Furlough Leave is mandatory for Nevada State employees and will result in a reduction of income of approximately 2.3% (or 4 hours per month) starting July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2015. The salary listed above does not reflect the reduction from the required furlough.

BENEFITS:

The State benefits package includes a retirement system, paid health, vision, dental, life and disability insurance; 11 paid holidays, and paid sick and annual leave. Other employee paid benefits such as deferred compensation plans are available.

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

This position reports to the Nevada Commissioner of Insurance. The candidate needs to be versed in the business of insurance and will need to ensure that all communications to the DOI are handled effectively, timely, and with the utmost professionalism. The Deputy Commissioner will need to work with the other senior leaders within the Division to communicate any trends or concerns regarding consumer issues.

The Deputy Commissioner will act as the consumer services liaison and be proactive in working to educate Nevada's consumers on the always evolving field of insurance. The Deputy Commissioner will supervise and direct the activities of the DOI investigatory staff.

Travel up to 25% is required. A valid driver's license or evidence of equivalent mobility is required at the time of appointment and as a condition of continued employment.

TO QUALIFY:

A four-year degree from an accredited university or college with major course work in business administration, economics, public administration, health administration or other related field required. A minimum of five years of managerial experience and seven years of insurance industry experience in governmental and/or private sector required. Ability to speak and present effectively in a public setting.
