GIS/Hydrology Technician (Well Supervisor)

The Nevada Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Division of Water Resources is seeking qualified applicants for the position of GIS/Hydrology Technician (Well Supervisor). This is a non-classified, full-time position within the Division of Water Resources located in Carson City, Nevada.

Recruitment: This is an open competitive recruitment, open to all qualified persons. Applications will be accepted until recruitment need is satisfied.

Approximate Annual Salary (DOE):

This is a non-classified position equivalent to an Engineering Technician III, Grade 30. The position is eligible for the State of Nevada Public Employees Benefit Program (PEBP). Please note: State of Nevada employees are required to take 48 hours of unpaid furlough leave per State fiscal year. The salary listed above does not reflect the reduction from the required furlough.

The Position: Responsible for field data collection and report writing for the Division's groundwater pumpage inventories for five hydrographic basins. Perform groundwater level measurements and stream flow measurements in various hydrographic basins and field investigations concerning various water right issues as assigned. Participate in the Division's Geographic Information Systems (GIS), including, but not limited to, data entry and database management, creation and review of GIS data and production of maps and presentation materials as needed by staff. This position will have some daily and overnight travel.

Minimum Qualifications: Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major course work in engineering, hydrology, mathematics or closely related field; **OR** an Associates' degree from an accredited college, university or technical school with major course work in engineering, engineering technology, geographic information systems (GIS), math, physical sciences, or related field and one year of technical experience. Candidates are required to possess and maintain as a condition of employment a valid Nevada driver's license.

- This position requires current State of Nevada driver license and ability to perform assigned tasks in the field in a wide range of weather and field conditions. Must be able to walk over varied terrain for distances of up to 0.5 miles carrying equipment weighing up to 40 pounds. Tasks require frequent lifting, bending and kneeling, reaching, grasping, pulling, occasional climbing, occasional wading in streams, and use of hand tools.
