Statewide Psychiatric Medical Director

The State of Nevada, Division of Public and Behavioral Health is currently seeking a **Statewide Psychiatric Medical Director** for the Division. Depending on candidates' preference, the position may be located in Las Vegas, NV or Reno/Carson, NV.

Under the administrative direction of the Chief Medical Officer, the Statewide Psychiatric Medical Director is responsible for oversight of all medical/psychiatric services provided by Northern Nevada Adult Mental Health Services, Southern Nevada Mental Health Services, Rural Clinics, and the maximum secured forensic facility, Lake Crossing. This includes in total, approximately 302 licensed inpatient beds, 86 licensed forensic beds, 4 urban and 16 rural outpatient medication clinics that employ more than 60 medical staff. The incumbent will be responsible for the medical supervision of behavioral health services for the Division with 50% of time dedicated to directing Agency Medical Staff and Associate Medical Director in the chosen location. Agencies are accredited by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) and by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Health Care Organizations. As a senior leader, will work jointly with Agency Administrators to oversee Agency Medical Staff in conjunction with the site Medical or Associate Medical Director to ensure appropriate Agency medical policies, procedures and by-laws are followed; Chair medical committees as required by policies and by-laws; Provide clinical services and medical oversight for mental health, substance abuse and DD/MR services for urban, rural and forensic facilities; Ensure regulatory and Joint Commission compliance; Manage residency program and assist with medical staff recruiting.

The successful candidate should be a clinical leader with the energy, knowledge and work ethic to make a difference. Willing to enhance stability to medical staff supervision, be committed to medical staff members, provide direction and vision for the provision of psychiatric care in this changing environment with an increase in the acuity due to the comorbidity of primary medical issues, psychiatric issues and forensic issues with the population served. Willing to challenge the norm, creative enough to introduce or recognize new ideas, confident enough to routinely partner with community leaders and respectful enough to encourage a successful medical operation to be best in class!

Board Certified/Board Eligible Psychiatrist, at least five (5) years of experience in a responsible position within a mental health setting and eligible for licensure in the State of Nevada.
