SUPERINTENDENT - Summit View Youth Center

The ***DIVISION OF CHILD AND FAMILY SERVICES (DCFS)*** is seeking a **Superintendent** for our Summit View Youth Center (SVYC), a 48-bed secure facility for male youth age 14 to 19 located in North Las Vegas, NV. As a member of the Juvenile Services Administration team the Superintendent is responsible for providing leadership, management, and oversight of the programmatic and operational components of the SVYC. Other responsibilities include: recruit, hire and training of staff; participate in the planning and implementation of the biennial budget; ensure appropriate educational, medical, dental and mental health services are provided for SVYC youth; prepare and submit monthly and biennial reports as required. Establish and maintain effective relationships with stakeholders including the community, agencies, and administrative representatives; coordinate services with Nevada Youth Parole Bureau relative to institutional release for the youth in our care.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE: The preferred candidate will have successful management and administrative experience in youth correctional programs embodying rehabilitative or delinquency prevention concepts. A minimum of two (2) years of administrative experience in an institution dealing primarily with youth on a 24-hour basis; a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, or have an equivalent combination of experience and training, substituting two (2) years of experience for one (1) year of training; availability to respond to after-hours emergencies.

SALARY AND BENEFITS: This position is compensated up to \$95,453. Excellent benefits package including health, dental and vision insurance, Public Employees Retirement Plan, three weeks paid vacation, three weeks sick leave, eleven paid holidays and no state, county, city or social security tax! In addition relocation assistance may be available.
