



Car Safety for Children

Keep your children safe in the car by following some basic safety rules.

- Make sure children are buckled up in the proper safety seats based on their ages:
 - Birth to age 2: Rear-facing car seat
 - Age 2 to age 5: Forward-facing car seat
 - Age 5 until seat belts fit: Booster seats
- Never use a safety seat that is more than 6 years old or past the expiration date.
- Children younger than 12 who have grown out of car and booster seats should be buckled in the back seat. Airbags can kill young children riding in the front seat.
- Set a good example for your children by always buckling up yourself.
