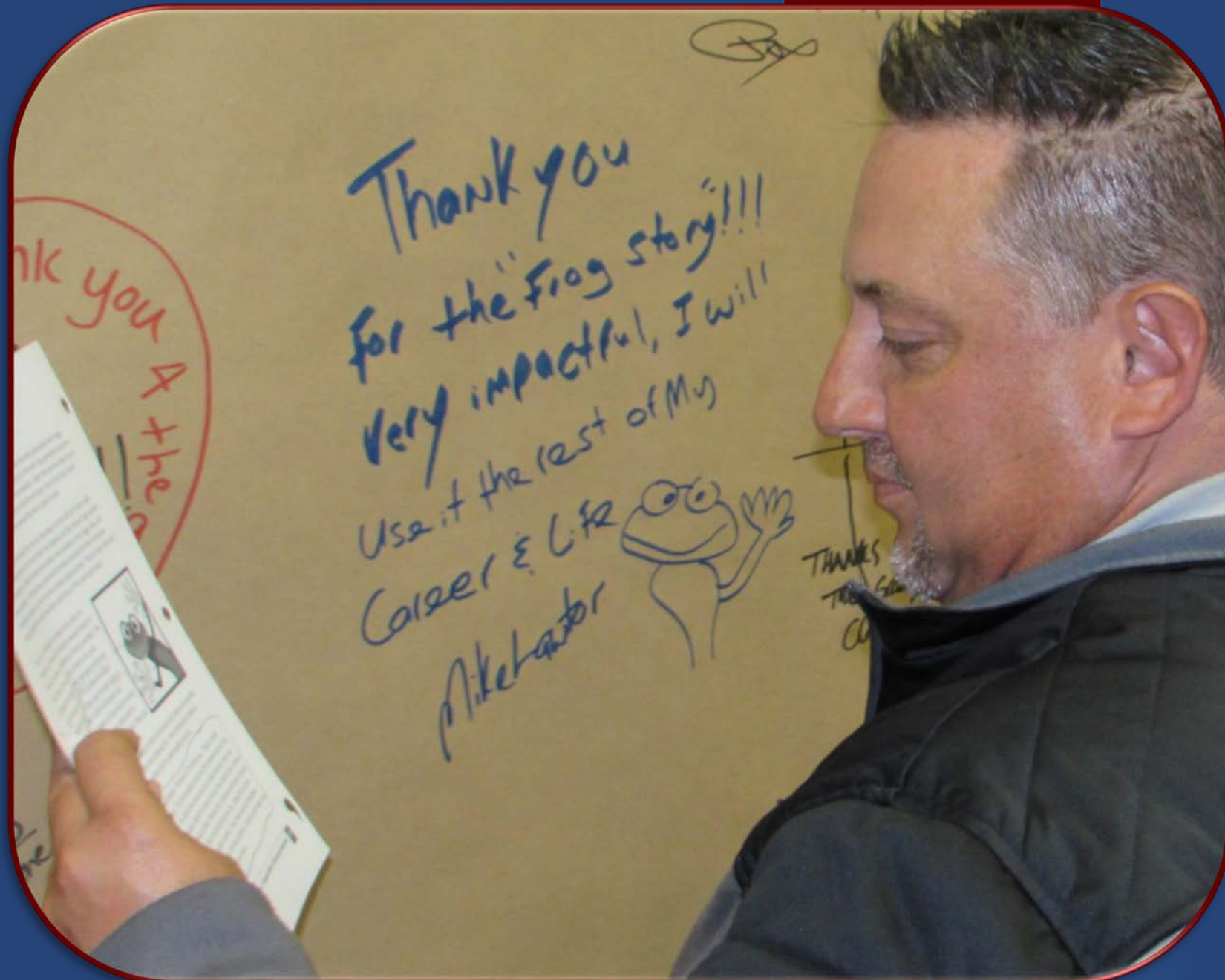
This class is filled with information that is applicable to all working in the public sector. The array of information covers so much.

NVCPM has taught me what it takes to be a good leader. You learn from, collaborate and network with some of the best leaders in the state.





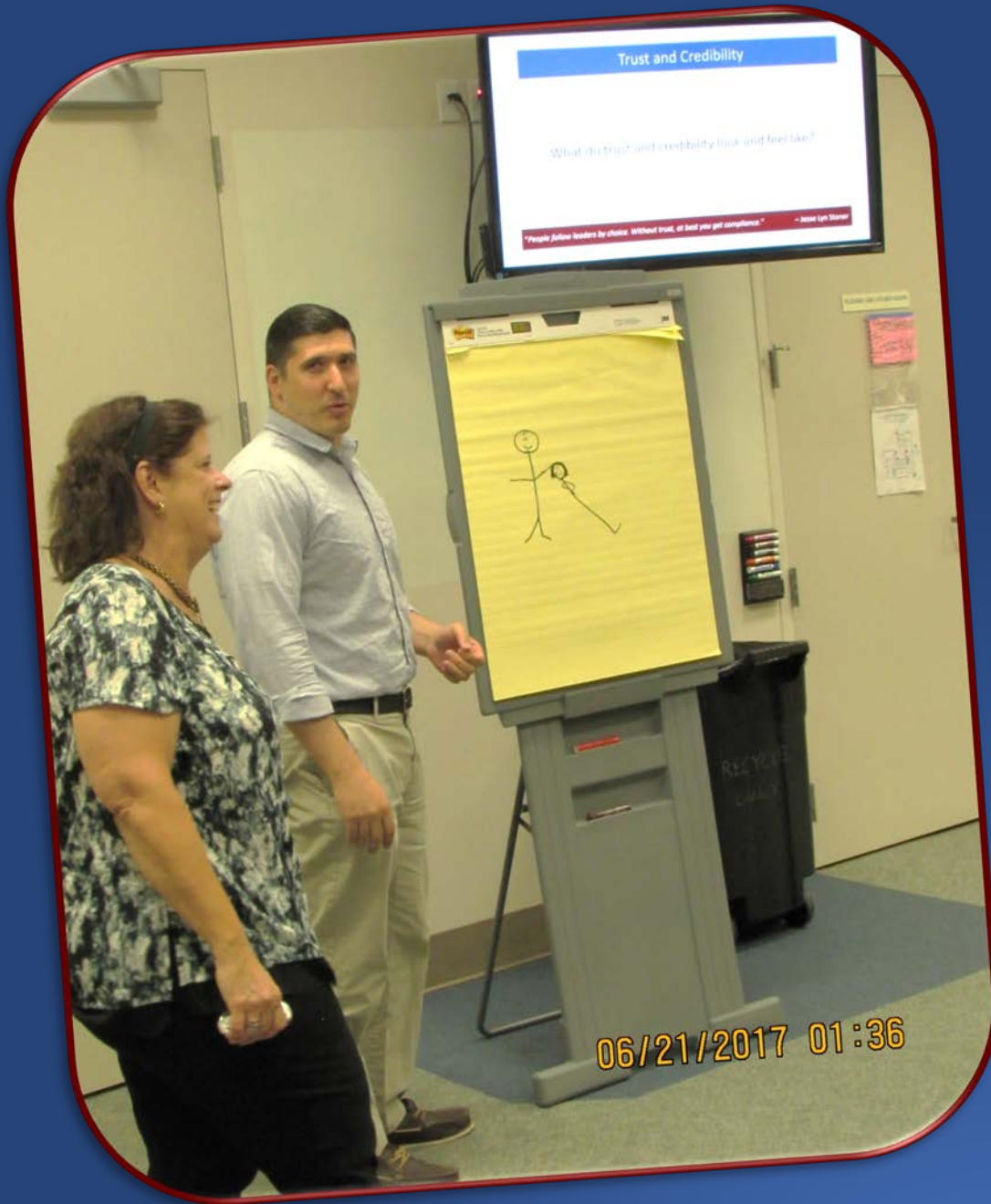
