Special Notes: Pursuant to NRS 284.4066, all positions in this class have been identified as affecting public safety. 1) Persons offered employment in the class must submit to preemployment screening for controlled substances 2) This position requires fingerprinting and a background investigation through the FBI and NCIC processes. 3) A valid license to practice dentistry in the State of Nevada is required at the time of appointment; and must be maintained throughout employment; without interruption.
