Investigators for the Private Investigators Licensing Board (PILB) perform investigations involving violations of federal and/or State laws pertaining to Chapter 648 of the Nevada Revised Statutes and Nevada Administrative Code. Investigations may be conducted based on public or private complaints received by the agency alleging unlicensed activity in the state and/or complaints received in the agency about a license holder or registered employee of the license holder. Additionally, these positions conduct comprehensive background checks on applicants applying for licensure and/or registered work cards. These positions conduct compliance audits, both in the office and out in the field, and work very closely with the Nevada Labor Commission, Federal, State, local law enforcement and other government licensing bodies. This position also provides testimony during Board meetings.
